

EVACUATION ORDER

WILDFIRE (Laidman Lake) #G41261 EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED July 20, 2024 at 1230 hours

Upon recommendation from BC Wildfire Service, an Evacuation Order has been issued by the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako effective July 20, 2024, at 1230 hours due to a wildfire.

Because of the **danger to life and health** the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako have issued an Evacuation Order **for all lands, properties, and dwellings in the vicinity of Laidman & Williamson Lakes, specifically those located west of Kluskus FSR, north of Moose Lake Road, and south of Malaput FSR, as per the attached map.**

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY.

Persons who disregard this Evacuation Order and remain in the Evacuation Order area do so at their own risk. The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako may be unable to assist anyone who remains in the Evacuation Order area.

- ➤ If you need transportation assistance from the area, please advise the individual providing this notice or call the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako at **250-692-1553**.
- Close all windows and doors.
- > Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- > Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help.
- > Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on a leash.
- > Do not use more vehicles than you must.
