Delegations

Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation

The Board received a presentation from the Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation to provide an overview regarding gravel extraction and processing at its Committee of the Whole Meeting on October 12th.

Widzin Kwah Water Sustainability Project

The Board had a presentation from the Office of the Wet'suwet'en and the Ministry of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship regarding the Widzin Kwah Water Sustainability Project and the working group. The Board appointed Director Chris Newell, Electoral Area G (Houston/Granisle Rural) to the Widzin Kwah Water Sustainability Project Working Group at its October 26th Board meeting.

TC Energy – Coastal GasLink

At the October 26th Board Meeting the Board received a presentation from TC Energy – Coastal GasLink regarding an update of its Phase 1 Project, Socio-Economics Effects Management Plan (SEEMP) and Phase 2 Outlook.

Regional Transit – Transit Service Bylaw Amendment

The Board gave third reading to the Bulkley-Nechako Transit Service Amendment Bylaws for Electoral Areas B, C, D and F to be included in the Bulkley-Nechako Transit Service. The Board also amended Bylaw No. 2017 at third reading to adjust the maximum requisition amount.
