# Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako Casual Class 1 and Class 3 Waste Haul Driver/Equipment Operator

The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako is seeking applicants to fill two casual positions for Class 1 and Class 3 Waste Haul Driver/Equipment Operator. This position will fill in when needed to provide sick and holiday coverage for part-time and full-time positions within the region.

Waste Haul Drivers and Equipment Operators are primarily responsible for transporting waste materials from RDBN transfer stations to RDBN landfills. This includes driving Class 1 and Class 3 vehicles and operating roll-off bin system, walking-floor trailers, and stationery Tran-store bins to unload waste. Drivers will also be required to load wood waste into trailers or bins with an excavator prior to hauling. This position is also responsible for conducting thorough pre-trip inspections, securing waste loads, and routine maintenance of haul trucks, trailers and equipment. Waste Haul Drivers will periodically be required to assist with other regional district hauling operations such as landfill cover, septage receiving beds maintenance, and special projects when directed.

The hourly wage for a Class 1 position is \$34.14, and for a Class 3 position, it is \$31.85. Both positions are subject to a 3-month probationary period and do not include a benefits package.

### **Responsibilities and Duties:**

- Haul municipal solid waste (garbage, wood, organics, etc.) in 53ft trailers, roll-off bins or dump trucks from RDBN Transfer Stations to Landfills.
- Haul equipment on a lowbed.
- Conduct thorough pre-trip inspections, routine maintenance and cleaning and minor repairs on trucks, trailers and equipment. This may include, but is not limited to changing tires, greasing, oil and filter changes, light bulb replacement, hose repair etc.
- Assist Landfills with periodic maintenance projects such as hauling and placing cover soil, and other hauling related activities.
- Assist with the maintenance and clean-out of RDBN septage receiving bed, which includes excavating solids from septage receiving beds and load into bins or dump truck
- Operate equipment (excavator).
- Mechanically break-down wood waste and load trailers and/or bins.
- Assist Transfer Station operations by stacking metal, wood, and compost piles.
- Feed and operate a grinder.
- Excavate and load soil from a quarry.
- Load excavator dozer or other equipment onto a lowbed trailer.
- Provide holiday and sick-time coverage primarily for waste haul drivers.
- Provide occasional on-call coverage during off-duty hours for all of the above.



• Other hauling related or equipment operation as required.

### **Skills and Qualifications:**

- Experience operating and maintaining heavy equipment including excavators, crawler dozers, loaders, dump trucks, roll-off trucks, skid steers, and 53ft tractor trailer units
- Minimum 2-years professional driving experience
- Experience operating and maintaining walking floor technology is preferred
- Experience performing general maintenance on truck and trailer units
- Ability to fill out logbooks, maintain records, and complete other documentation
- Experience running and maintaining excavators
- Be physically fit
- Ability to work in groups and independently to complete tasks
- Good communication skills
- Safety conscious
- Good public relations skills
- Comfortable with technology (computers, smartphones, tablets)
- Ability to receive and carry out detailed instructions independently
